#### **EXPERIENCE**

Cardiff Animation Festival: Director | March 2015 – present. I established the biennial Cardiff Animation Festival, and led a team of 12 staff and 23 volunteers to plan and organise the inaugural festival, which ran 19-22 April 2018, reaching attendance figures of over 5000. I built partnerships with 35 other organisations, assembled an advisory committee of industry leaders, fundraised revenue from grants and sponsorship and secured extensive in-kind contributions, as well as handling business administration and leading in a public-facing role.
